Further education offers a wide range of qualifications and training programmes, to a student who has completed Occupational Studies qualifications before leaving school. At NRC your Occupational Studies qualification counts as GCSE equivalent for entry requirements to courses. You may be thinking of taking up a vocational qualification for example a Diploma in Media, Sport or Construction or a training programme in a trade such as Joinery, Brickwork or Hairdressing.
