RE: ULN Privacy Notice update

Dear Super User,

The Learning Records Service (LRS) has recently updated its privacy notice in light of recent EU developments around GDPR. This updated privacy notice means that consent for data sharing is no longer required under the rule of data for the public good.

There is no issue if you have already distributed privacy notice documentation for 2018-19. If you haven't already distributed a privacy notice, or for future use, a shortened privacy notice (which no longer requires consent) should be shared with learners. This new, shortened privacy notice can be seen below (Tier 1).

**Tier 1 privacy notice**

The information you supply is used by the Learning Records Service (LRS). The LRS issues Unique Learner Numbers (ULN) and creates Personal Learning records across England, Wales and Northern Ireland, and is operated by the Education and Skills Funding Agency, an executive agency of the Department for Education (DfE).
