GCSE Construction

Further information on the use of eCandidate Record Sheets in 2019

As communicated in June's circular (S/IF/34/18), GCSE Construction will be among those subjects using eCandidate Record Sheets (eCRS) to submit marks to CCEA for visiting moderated units in summer 2019. While most Construction departments may have prior experience of using eCRS, the visiting unit will work to different deadlines and information on this is provided below.

Using eCRS will remove the need to complete record sheets manually, as well as the requirement to fill in and submit hard copy TAC1 and TAC2 forms. Submission of marks, in addition to declarations of authentication and internal standardisation, will now be done online. Examinations officers must register users to appropriate units to allow eCRS to be accessed. Further details on the use of eCRS will be provided at the Agreement Trials, and attendance at these is therefore recommended.

In the grid below are the intended key dates (at time of publication) for eCRS in 2018-19. These will be confirmed at Agreement Trials. Closing dates will also be displayed within the eCRS application.
