

PREFACE

This booklet contains statistics which describe the outcomes of the GCSE, GCE A/AS, AEA and Occupational studies examinations, Spring and Summer 2004, and the GCSE Examinations, Winter 2003, conducted by the Northern Ireland Council for the Curriculum, Examinations and Assessment. The same sets of tabulations are included for each examination and are detailed in the contents list which follows.

Results of GCSE Examinations are issued in the form of eight grades A* to G in descending order of merit. This section is split between full and short course examinations. Candidates who fail to reach the minimum standard are ungraded.

Results of the GCE A and Advanced Subsidiary Examinations are classified into five grades of pass lettered A to E in descending order of merit. There is also an unclassified category.

Results of the AEA examinations are classified into two pass grades, Distinction and Merit lettered D and M. There is also an unclassified category.

Results of the Occupational studies examinations are classified into five grades of pass numbered 1 to 5. There is also an unclassified category.

The grade outcomes in this booklet are broken down by examination centre type as well as by gender. The centre classifications within the booklet are Grammar Schools, Non-grammar Schools, Further Education Colleges and Other (which also includes entries from privately entered candidates).

The Council is prepared to respond to bona fide requests for further statistical information for research or other purposes, provided the Council is satisfied as to the nature of the use for which the information is required.
