Pupils' Personal Learning Targets

SIOBHAN MATTHEWSON: Pupils in our school have always set personal learning targets, regardless of whether it has been a manual reporting system or an electronic reporting system, because we see that as a very important feature of their learning.

From the reports that we have sent out to parents over the last number of years whilst using electronic reporting, our students have done their target setting with their subject teachers, subsequent to the reports being sent out, and also with their form teacher.

So the students get an opportunity to meet with their subject teacher, and then subsequent to that, we have a special day called Target Setting Day, where every pupil in the school comes in and has an individual appointment with their form tutor, and that will allow them then to review their targets, to see how they're going to be met, and to allow the form teacher to get an overall view of how that pupil is progressing.
