Internal Appeals on Coursework/Controlled Assessment

In this dispatch you will also have received a communication from the Head of Regulation in Northern Ireland, Roger McCune. This communication clarifies the regulatory position on the changes introduced by AQA, OCR, Pearson and WJEC in how internal appeals in GCE and GCSE internal assessments must be conducted.

I can confirm in line with this communication, that CCEA Awarding Organisation **will not** introduce changes to the conduct of internal appeals for its coursework/controlled assessment units in summer 2018.

The current requirement for CCEA specifications is that centres should have an internal appeals policy in place for coursework/controlled assessments. This will continue to apply until further notice.
