GCSE and GCE Technology and Design

Centres are reminded of the page limits in each specification for the coursework and controlled assessment units.

GCSE Technology and Design

The design portfolio should be a maximum of ten A3 sheets on one side only or equivalent.

AS Technology and Design

The portfolio should include written and graphical information produced on not more than 10 A3 sheets.

A2 Technology and Design

The portfolio should include written and graphical information produced on not more than 20 A3 sheets.

It is the teacher's responsibility to ensure that candidates do not exceed the page limits. If a candidate exceeds these page limits, moderators have been instructed to review only the first 10 at GCSE and AS level and the first 20 at A" level.

Centres are also reminded that printed copies of the Candidate Record Sheets must be provided for the moderator during the moderation process.
