## GCSE and GCE Technology and Design

Centres are reminded of the page limits in each specification for the coursework and controlled assessment units.

GCSE Technology and Design

*The design portfolio should be a maximum of ten A3 sheets on one side only or equivalent.*

AS Technology and Design

*The portfolio should include written and graphical information produced on not more than 10 A3 sheets.*

A2 Technology and Design

*The portfolio should include written and graphical information produced on not more than 20 A3 sheets.*

It is the teacher's responsibility to ensure that candidates do not exceed the page limits. If a candidate exceeds these page limits, moderators have been instructed to review only the first 10 at GCSE and AS level and the first 20 at A" level.
