Minimum Assessment Completion for Enhanced Grading in Cases of Acceptable Absence

In January 2019, the NI Regulator wrote to schools in Northern Ireland and to CCEA confirming that the minimum acceptable assessment completion requirement for enhanced grading is 40%.

I write to advise you that this determination has now been reflected in the Joint Council for Qualification's (JCQ) guidance - *A Guide to the Special Consideration Process, General & Vocational Qualifications, with effect from 1st September 2018*, chapter 4, pages 8 and 9.
