## Entry Level Qualifications (ELQ) – Introduction of eCRS

As part of the next phase of E-Moderation, CCEA is expanding the range of subjects using eCRS to record marks and confirm submissions. From the March 2020 series, centres will use the eCRS application for all Entry Level Qualifications. This means that centres will be required to complete and submit their marks and admin using the eCRS application, rather than the hardcopy record sheets, TAC1 and TAC2 forms used previously.

Examinations Officers can register users to each entered unit through the E-Moderation Admin application in CCEA's Central Login. Registered users will be able to access ELQ eCandidate Record Sheets for the March 2020 series in November.
