Mock Examinations 2022

CCEA is running **mock examinations** in January 2022. CCEA recommends that **all** centres who plan to enter candidates in Summer 2022 take part in the mocks to give practice to candidates using the examination system and also to technicians during setup. If your centre has never run the examination before then the mock will be a **requirement** before your centre undertakes the live examination, to ensure that all systems will run smoothly on the day.

Please Note: CCEA may use some of the completed mock examination scripts internally for trial marking purposes. However, this will be for examiner marking training only and these marks will not be issued to centres. Candidate scripts will be returned to the teacher a few days after the examination along with the mark scheme and any associated stimulus.

The A2 Moving Image Arts specification requires candidates to recall knowledge from throughout the GCE course. Therefore, to aid your preparation for the forthcoming January **mock** examination, we are providing you with content areas that will feature in the A2 mock questions.

Areas featured in Questions 1 and 2 will be **Realism** (in a contemporary film) and **Poetic Realism**.

Areas featured in Question 4 will be **Realism** and **Formalism**.
