Online Marking of AS Technology and Design STE12

For Summer 2023 and onwards, the AS Technology and Design STE12 paper will be marked online.

The change to online marking will not affect the structure and format of the examination paper.

The questions will still be provided in booklet form and candidates will still be required to provide responses to the questions within the booklet.

The spacing for responses remains the same, whether in written or diagrammatic form.

However, as the examination papers will be marked online, each page will have a boxed area that contains the question and response space. Candidates must not write outside the boxed area on each page as this will not be copied across when scanned for online marking.

Questions which require drawing or sketching should be completed using an H.B. pencil.

All other questions must be completed using black ink only, do not write in pencil or with a gel pen.

Furthermore, there may be blank pages within the booklet. Candidates must not write anything on these pages, as again, they will not be scanned.

Please ensure candidates are aware of the above.
