The following examination papers are being marked online from Summer 2024 onwards:

GRE11: The Christian Church through a Study of the Catholic Church and the Protestant Church

GRE22: The Christian Church with a Focus on the Protestant Church

GRE31: The Revelation of God and the Christian Church

GRE81: Islam

GRE91: Judaism
