Examination papers: Units moving to online marking in Summer 2024 and onwards

Both examination papers for GCSE Units **GLE11** and **GLE21** will be marked online in the Summer 2024 examination series and onwards.

Please note and ensure candidates are made aware of the following:

- Candidates will still be required to answer on the question paper.
- As the question papers will be marked online, each page will have a boxed area that contains the response space.
- Candidates must not write outside the boxed area on each page as this will not be copied across when scanned for marking.
- Furthermore, there may be pages marked “blank pages” and candidates must not write anything on these pages, as again, they will not be scanned.
- Candidates must complete questions in black ink and not write with a gel pen.
