GCE Chemistry: Change of format for Section A (Multiple-Choice Questions) in examination papers

From the Summer 2025 series, the multiple-choice questions in Section A of the GCE Chemistry examination papers (units SCH14 (AS1), SCH24 (AS2), ACH14 (A21) and ACH24 (A22)) will change in terms of how candidates indicate their responses. Candidates will be asked to circle the correct answer below the question. A sample question is shown below.

Section A

For each of the following questions, only **one** of the lettered responses (A-D) is correct.

Select the correct response for each question by circling the appropriate letter below the question.

1 Which one of the following does **not** contain an asymmetric centre?

- A $\text{CH}_3\text{CH}(\text{CH}_3)\text{CH}_2\text{CH}_3$
- B $\text{CH}_3\text{CH}(\text{OH})\text{CH}_2\text{CH}_3$
- C $\text{CH}_3\text{CHClCH}_2\text{CH}_3$
- D $\text{CH}_3\text{CH}(\text{NH}_2)\text{CH}_2\text{CH}_3$
