Principal Moderator's Report

The Performance Skills January Series 2014 produced some excellent work from candidates. Candidates showed a range of good technical ability during their performances.

The team viewed many different performance techniques employed by candidates and these ranged from displays of dance, vocal (solo work and choral), instrumental (solo and quartets) and acting skills.

All CCEA documentation was completed correctly by centre assessors and internal verifiers. It was clear that all centres complied with CCEA guidelines and instructions and this was evident during the moderation visits. It was recognised that centres had benefited from CCEA organised training events held during the year as the documentation completed showed good assessment outcomes.

Tutor/Assessor reports given on all the candidates' work were encouraging and this allowed all the candidates to achieve their full potential.

All candidates achieving the award presented tracking booklets which were completed correctly containing all relevant information for both the Level 1 and Level 2 qualification.
