Part A

John, aged 46, has lived with his partner Susan for 20 years. They have two children, Amy who is 18 years old and Mark who is 14 years old.

John has recently been diagnosed with dementia. His short term memory is poor and he has difficulty carrying out everyday tasks such as dressing himself. John often forgets simple words and can become disorientated, forgetting the days of the week, confusing night with day and recently he was unable to find his way home after going for a short walk.

(i) Analyse how John's family may meet his physical and emotional needs.

(ii) Evaluate the effectiveness of the informal sector in meeting John's needs.

(iii) Carry out an investigation and describe the services provided by the statutory sector in your local area which help to meet the needs of service users with dementia.
