## Individual Presentation and Interaction “Nazi Germany”

#### Level 3 - Mark 12

- Steven effectively communicates information, ideas and some feelings and promotes issues. Confidently conveys information, emphasising significant points e.g. “But perhaps the most pivotal piece of persuasion...”, “and then there are the law courts of course...”
- Attempts to adapt talk to a variety of situations and audiences by using the non-verbal feature of a parenthesis gesture — “the right verdict”, “German principles”
- Interprets his material: “Personally...” but doesn’t develop opinions
- Uses some well-judged vocabulary and sentence structures including competent and appropriate use of standard English. Structures and sustains talk e.g. “Moving on...”, “Now finally moving on to the third point of our discussion”
- His pace impacts diction and the flow of the talk in places
