### **Assessment Arrangements for candidates completing in 2022**

1. For candidates wishing to cash-in for an Entry Level qualification in March 2022, centres can choose to omit units of their choice worth **up to 60 Guided Learning Hours (GLH)**:
  - Centre enters candidates and delivers the specification for 9 units, as detailed in the specification. This may include work completed prior to 2021-22.
  - Centres may choose to omit units representing a maximum of 60 GLH from assessment and assess candidates only on the remaining units.
  - Units that have been previously awarded at unit level without a cash-in at qualification level will count towards the number of units required for cash-in at qualification level in March 2022.
2. Unit level awards will still be available and moderated in the normal way.
