

# Entry Level Physical Education Specification Addendum

## Exceptional Assessment Adaptations (for 2021–2022)

**This addendum should be used in conjunction with the current specification**  
**Please note: This applies only to candidates cashing-in at qualification level in March 2022**

1. No temporary adaptations have been made to this specification due to public health.
2. For candidates wishing to cash-in for an Entry Level qualification in March 2022, centres can choose to **omit up to three units** of their choice, worth up to a maximum of 60 GLH:
  - Centre delivers the content for six units, as detailed in the specification. This may include work completed prior to 2021-22.
  - Centres may choose to omit one, two or three units of their choice from assessment and assess candidates only on the remaining units.
  - Centre enters candidates for only the units they will be assessed on.
  - Units that have been previously awarded at unit level without a cash-in at qualification level will count towards the number of units required for cash-in at qualification level in March 2022.
3. Unit level awards will still be available and moderated in the normal way.
4. Visiting Moderation will be in place for March 2022; however, CCEA will keep this under review in light of the changing public health context.
