AS 2: Personal Response	Students present a personal outcome in response to the theme. Students bring this to completion during a 10 hour controlled test. Teachers assess the controlled task, and we moderate their marks. Assessment Objective 4 more heavily weighted than Assessment Objectives 1, 2 and 3.	50% of AS 20% of A level	This unit will be eligible for omission for candidates cashing in for the AS level qualification grade in Summer 2022. This unit will still be available for any candidates wishing to be assessed in all units.

A statement of intent; 2. An outcome; and 3. An evaluation. <p>The marks for this unit will be 36 marks. 1. AS Summer 2022

For those students who are due to cash in the AS Level qualification in Summer 2022, should they choose to sit both units, they will receive the higher of either:

- the grade awarded on the basis of the outcome of the required units specified by CCEA; or
- the grade awarded on the basis of the outcome of the full set of units for that qualification.

In both cases the full specification content should still be delivered.

2. AS (2021) contribution to GCE Qualification (2022)

For candidates who started their course in September 2020 and hope to achieve a GCE qualification level grade in Summer 2022, they will be awarded a grade based on their performance in their A2 units only.

3. Teaching Order

For candidates commencing their AS or A2 course in September 2021, it is recommended that, as far as possible, the units are delivered in numerical order in case of any further disruption to the academic year.
