Awarding A* A Level Single Award (6 units):	<p>A* grade will be awarded to candidates who have met both of the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> gain an A grade overall at A level (480+ UMS out of 600 UMS); and gain 90%, or more, of the maximum UMS on the combined totals of their A2 units (324+ UMS out of 360 UMS).
Awarding A*A* A Level Double Award (12 units)	<p>An A*A* grade will be awarded to candidates who have met both of the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> gain an AA grade overall at Double Award A level (960+ UMS out of 1200 UMS); and gain 90%, or more, of the max UMS on the combined totals of their six A2 units (648+ UMS out of 720 UMS).
Awarding A*A A2 Double Award (12 units)	<p>An A*A grade will be awarded to candidates who have met both of the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> gain an AA grade overall at Double Award A level (960+ UMS out of 1200 UMS); and gain 90%, or more, of the max UMS on their best three A2 units (324+ UMS out of 360 UMS).

The A* grade will be awarded for A level qualifications only. It will not be awarded at AS level or for individual units.
