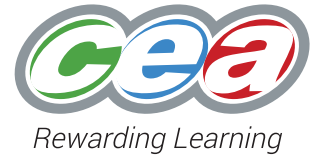

Tolerance stated is relative to the A and E grades.

The B, C and D grades will always be evenly distributed between A and E grades.

Examples

Mathematics AS1:

- (i) Using a tolerance of + 4 and – 4 in A and E grades respectively:
A is 80 and E is 31. Then B would be 67; C would be 55 and D would be 43.
- (ii) Using a tolerance of +4 in both A and E grades:
A is 80 and E is 39. Then B would be 69; C would be 59 and D would be 49.
- (iii) Using a tolerance of +3 and +1 in A and E grades respectively:
A is 79 and E is 36. Then B would be 68; C would be 57 and D would be 46.



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
