



## Practice

- Do past papers.
- Practise with questions in the Irish for CCEA GCSE textbook.
- Practise identifying the verbal noun, e.g. *ag imirt, ag dul, ag ceannach, ag rá*
- Practise recognising different ways of saying the same thing, i.e. some language manipulation.
- Use all the time given!
