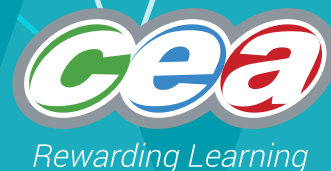

Here are some key points to help you study this topic.

Learning Outcomes

You should be able to:

- understand and respond to different types of stimulus reading material;
- understand details within texts using high frequency familiar language;
- identify the overall message, key points, details and opinions in a variety of written passages;
- deduce meaning from a variety of written texts including short narratives, authentic material and unfamiliar material;

- recognise and respond to key information, important themes and ideas in extended written text and authentic sources;
- demonstrate understanding, by being able to scan for particular information, organise and present relevant details, draw conclusions in context and recognise implicit meaning where appropriate;
- translate sentences from Irish into English.

These lists are neither prescriptive nor exhaustive.

Skills

- To show good understanding of a variety of stimulus reading material that contain a variety of vocabulary, structures, verbs and tenses.
- To understand some unfamiliar language and extract meaning from more complex language.
- To be able to translate passages, sentences and short phrases in Irish.
- To deduce meaning from a variety of written texts.
- To identify details and points of view.
- To extract details and points of view and draw conclusions.
- To understand gist, attitudes and emotions and draw conclusions (Higher Tier).
- To be able to understand past, present and future events including some unfamiliar language.
- To be able to respond to stimulus reading material by completing gap-filling, answers in English and answers in Irish.

- To watch Irish language television and listen to Irish radio stations for greater exposure to target language.
