You will be required to complete a series of short grammatical and lexical exercises in French.

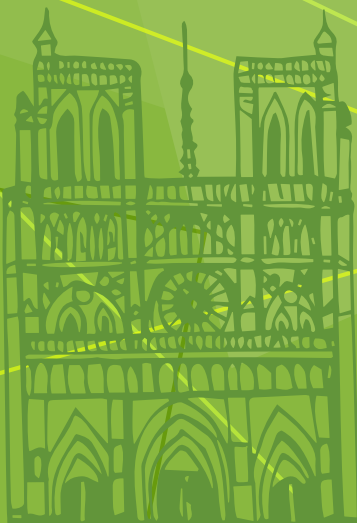
Assessment
