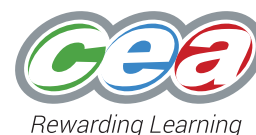

Can you mark written assessments through the medium of Irish?
Do you live in the Republic of Ireland and need to apply for a National
Insurance number in order to work with us?

Applying is easy!

You can apply for a National Insurance number online at
www.gov.uk/apply-national-insurance-number

If you have any of the following documents, get them ready before you start:

- a passport from any country
- a biometric residence permit (BRP)
- a national identity card from an EU country.

Once you have proven your identity, it can take up to 16 working days to get
your National Insurance number.

*Please note: If you live in Ireland and have the right to work in the United
Kingdom, you can apply for work without first having a National Insurance
number. Where an application process **requests** your National Insurance
number, it is usually sufficient to say that it is **not yet received**.*
