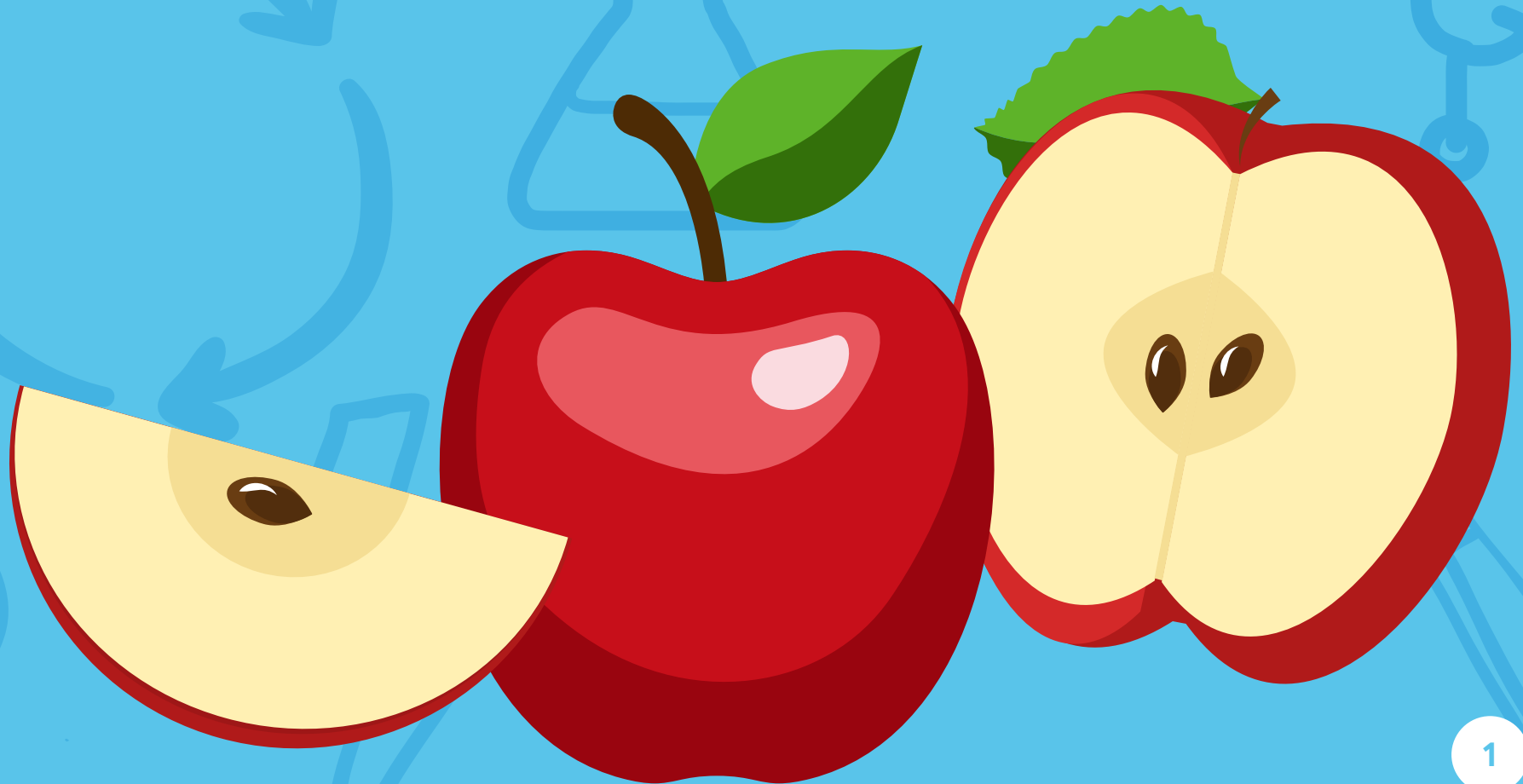
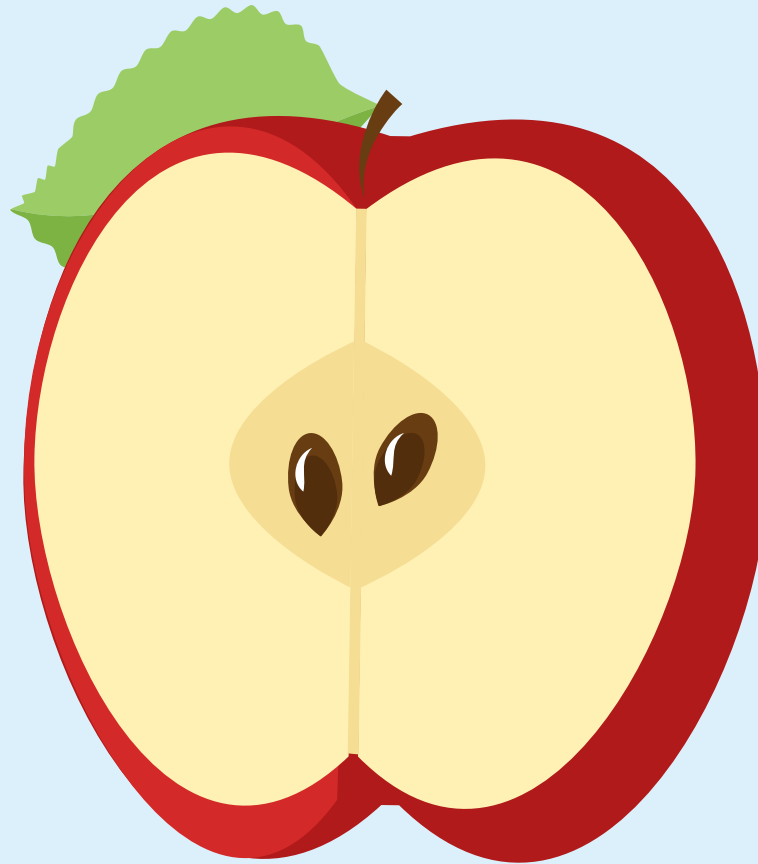


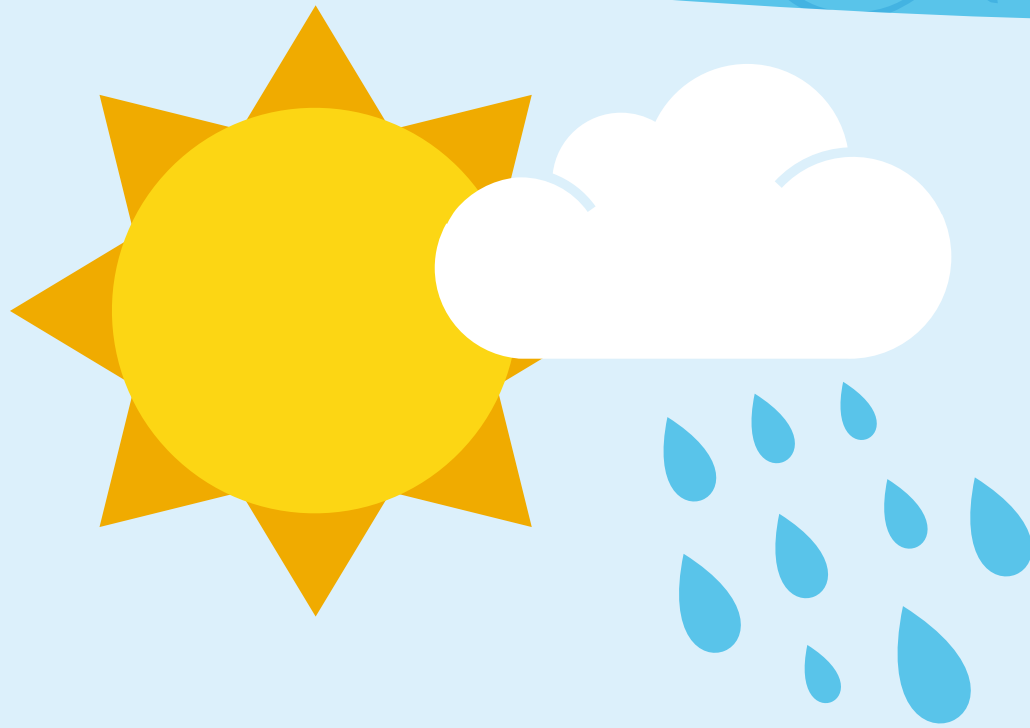

'Life Cycle of an Apple' Story

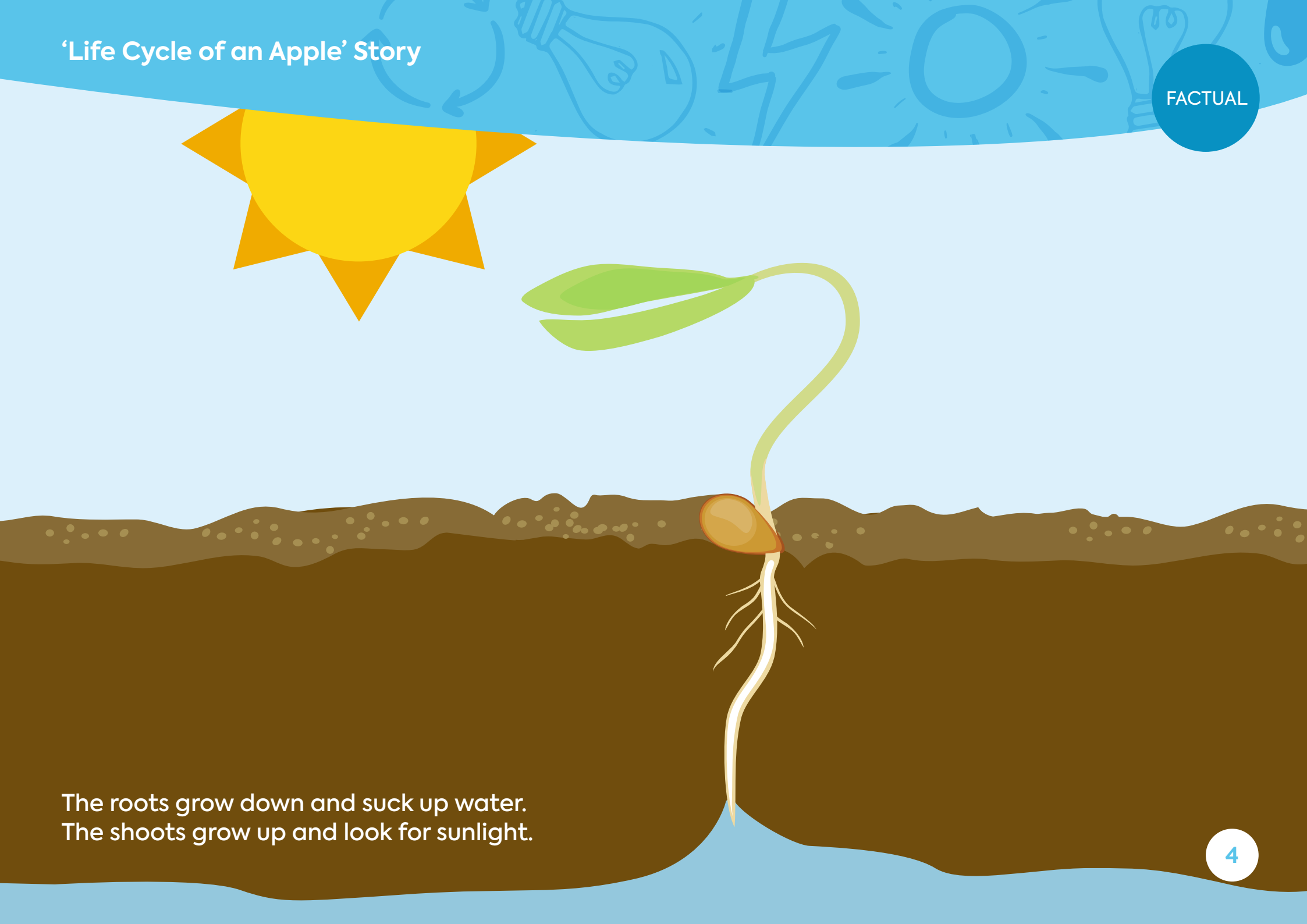




If you cut open an apple, you will find seeds inside the core.
