

Problem

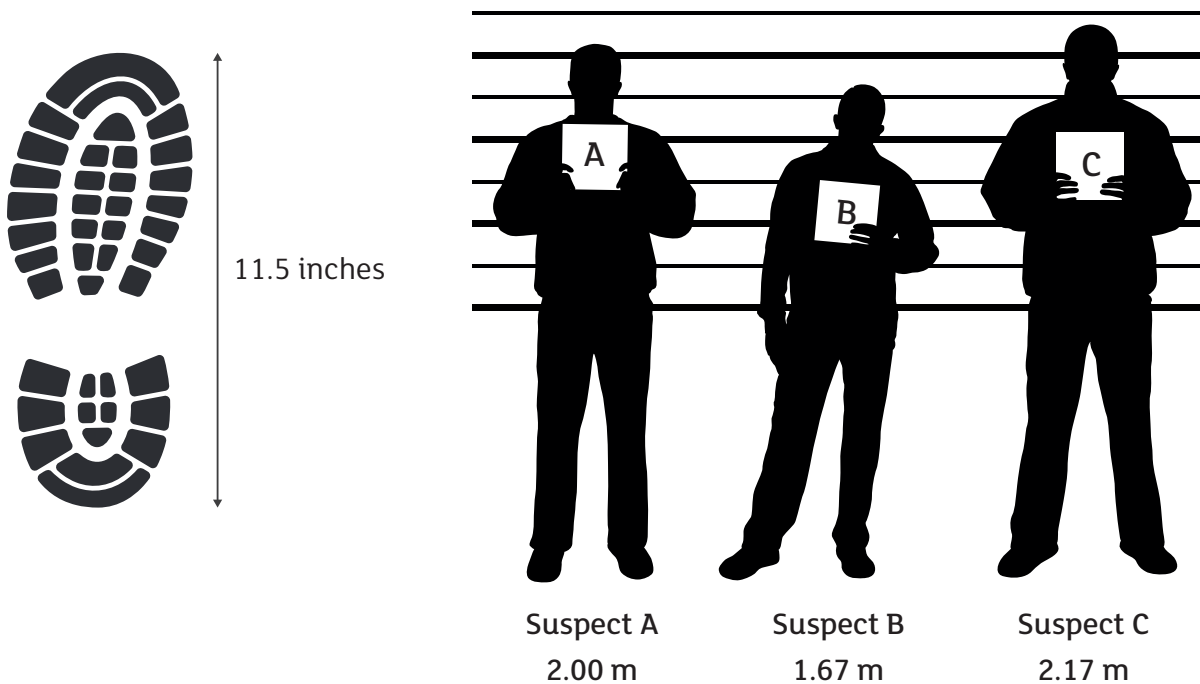
Forensic scientists and police make use of a height to foot size ratio.

If they know the size of someone's foot or footprint, they can use this ratio to estimate the height of the person that left it.

Usually, the height to foot size ratio is 6.6:1, measured in inches.

The police have found a footprint of 11.5 inches at a crime scene.

They have three suspects with different heights:



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Which suspect is most likely to have left the footprint?
