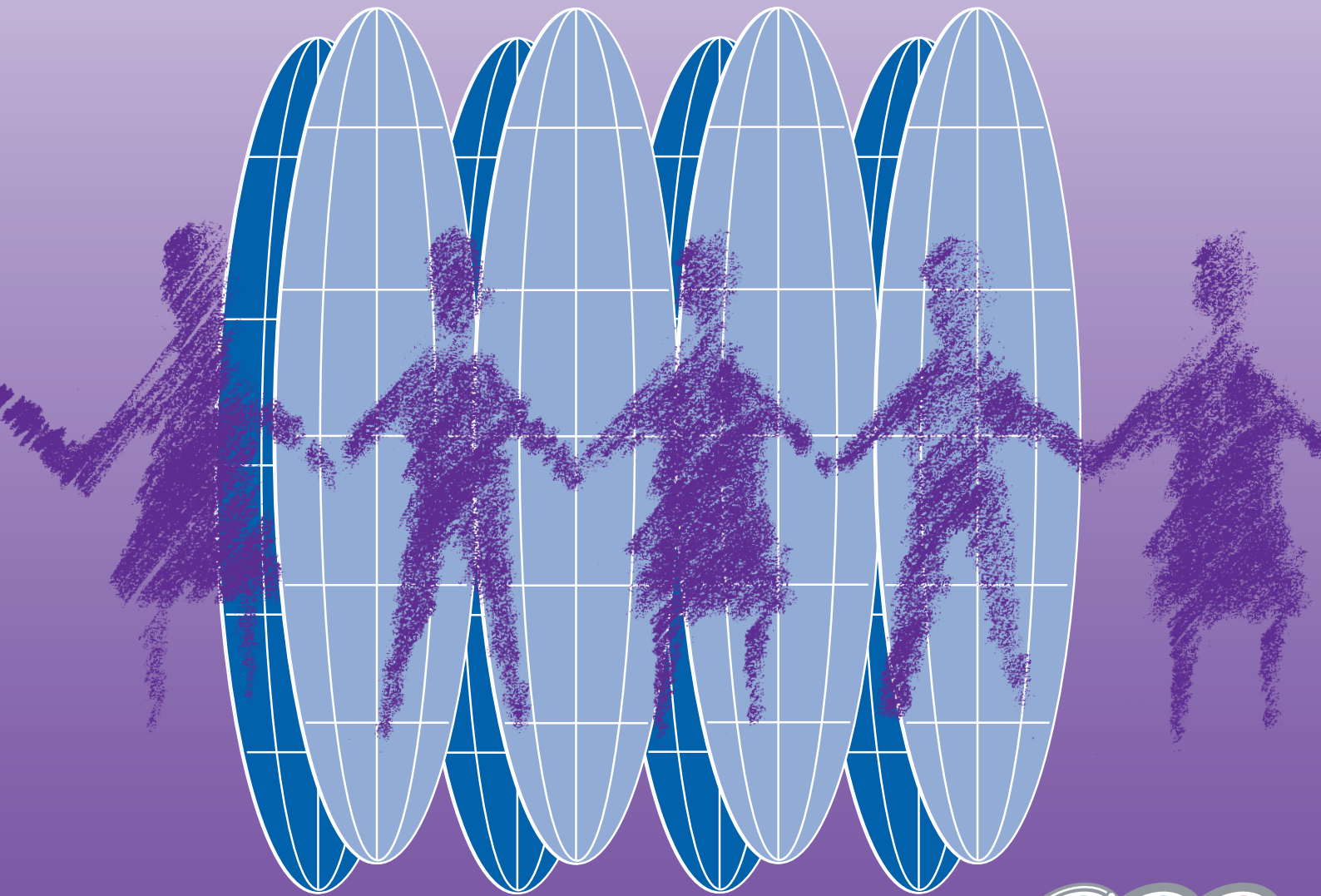

If you think your character could say "Yes" to a statement then circle **one** of the footprints, starting from the **bottom** of the page.


Keep going until your teacher has read **all** the statements and see how far you can get up the page

People whisper behind me on the street about my appearance... saying things like I'm dirty...




I don't like it when people say I'm stupid




People talk about me as if I wasn't there!!

things as everyone else




I'm tired of people

let me in!




My youth club doesn't have

Stereotype	A description of, or attitude about, a group of people who have something in common which ignores differences between individuals eg "All girls are cry babies"
Prejudice	A personal opinion of someone or a group of people based on a stereotype or on very little knowledge or fact eg "I hate Man Utd. fans- they're all full of themselves"
Discrimination	Treating someone unfairly (or less favourably) because of their religion, gender, background, ethnic group, age etc. eg not having easy access to a public building for people with disabilities
Racism	Treating someone unfairly (or less favourably) or having a prejudice against someone because of the colour of their skin or ethnic background eg "Our football team won't have black players"
Sectarianism	Treating someone unfairly (or less favourably) or having a prejudice against someone because of their religion eg "Our factory won't employ Catholics/Protestants"
Sexism	Treating someone unfairly (or less favourably) or having a prejudice against someone because of their gender eg "Men are no good at looking after babies"
Ageism	Treating someone unfairly (or less favourably) or having a prejudice against someone because of their age eg "People over 55 can't apply for this promotion"
Homophobia	Having a prejudice against someone because of their sexual orientation eg "I wouldn't let a gay man in my home"
