

Subtraction with Exchange

Nearly There – Card 7



So far, all our subtraction calculations have used the words **subtraction**, **minus** and **take away**. Here are some more words that can be used in subtraction calculations.

Find the difference between 321 and 514.

Decrease 403 by 164.

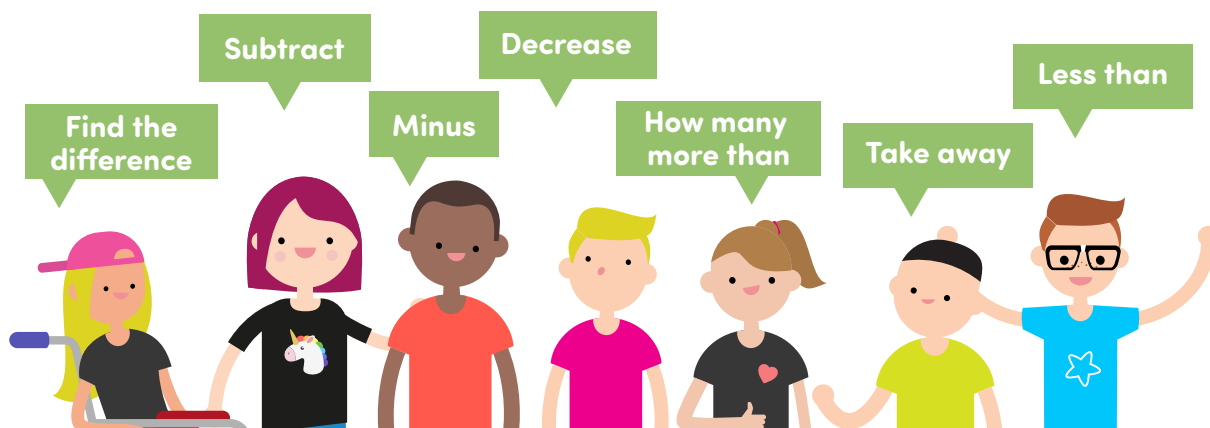
How many more than 318 is 417?

How many less than 666 is 338?

These calculations may seem more difficult, but you already know how to solve them. They are just using different words.

Remember to use what you already know about subtraction calculations.

1. Subtraction questions can use lots of different words but **the calculations are all similar**.



2. In a subtraction calculation the **top number is always the larger of the two**.

3. **Record your calculation clearly** to help to stop you getting mixed up.

4. The symbol, Hundreds, Tens and Units each have **separate columns**.

Now, try these calculations before checking the answer card:

1. Find the difference between 321 and 514.
2. How many more than 318 and 417?
3. Decrease 403 by 164.
4. How many less than 666 is 328?

Remember, in a subtraction calculation, the top number is always the larger number!

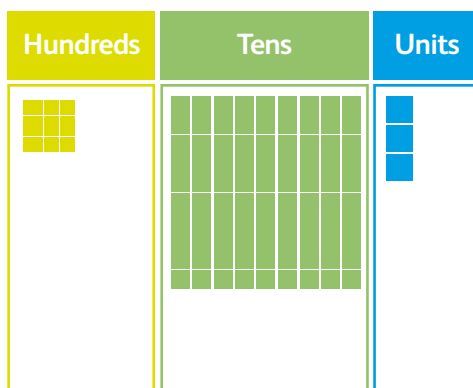

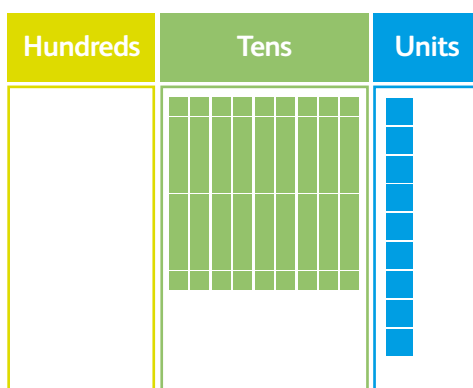
