

Subtraction with Exchange

Nearly There – Card 8



So far, all our subtraction calculations have used the words **subtraction**, **minus** and **take away**. Here are some more words that can be used in subtraction calculations.

Find the difference between 138 and 467.

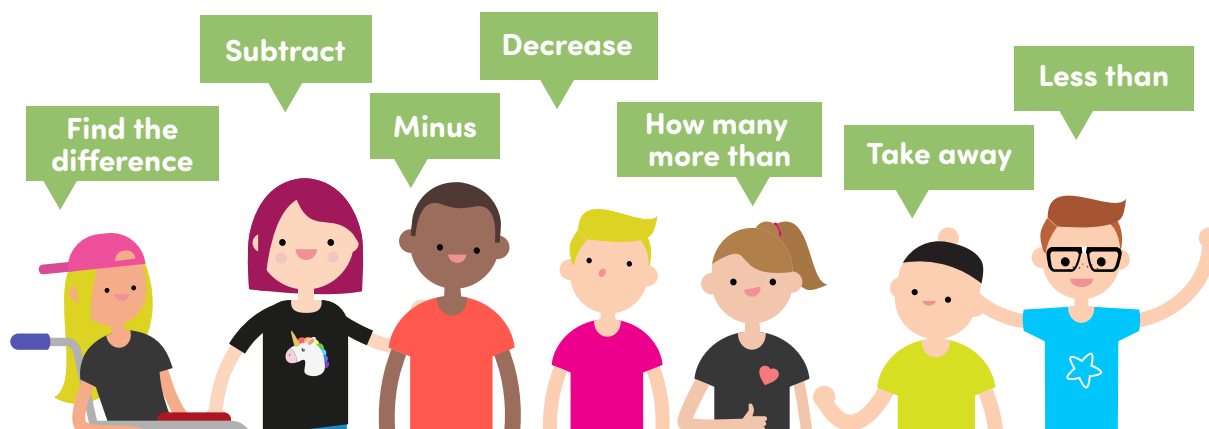
Decrease 594 by 249.

How many more than 317 is 328?

How many less than 586 is 257?

Remember to use what you already know about subtraction calculations.

1. Subtraction questions can use lots of different words but **the calculations are all similar**.



2. In a subtraction calculation the **top number is always the larger of the two**.

3. **Record your calculation clearly** to help to stop you getting mixed up.

4. The symbol, Hundreds, Tens and Units each have **separate columns**.

Now, try these calculations before checking the answer card:

1. Find the difference between 138 and 467.
2. How many more than 317 is 645?
3. Decrease 594 by 249.
4. How many less than 586 is 257?

Remember, in a subtraction calculation, the top number is always the larger number!

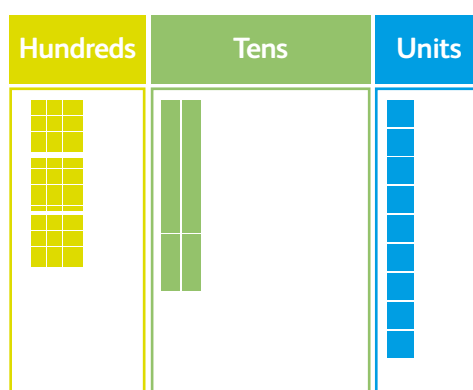

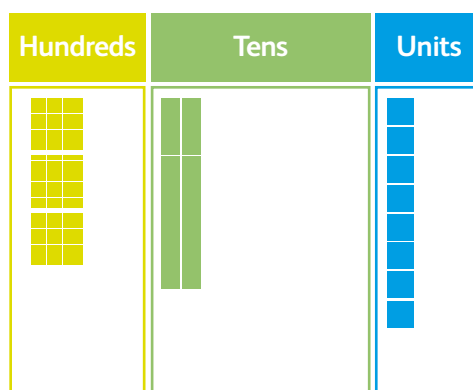
