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








This book describes some jobs in the local community. Pupils who go on work experience might try some of these jobs. This helps them find out what they enjoy.



This is a café. Jobs in a café might include wiping tables, serving food, washing dishes and cleaning the floor.



This is a garden centre. Jobs in a garden centre might include watering plants, helping customers, potting plants and brushing paths.



This is a charity shop. Jobs in a charity shop might include hanging clothes, stacking books, serving customers and cleaning up.



This is a garage. Jobs in a garage might include washing cars, cleaning parts, brushing the floor and answering the telephone.



This is a hairdresser's. Jobs in a hairdresser's might include hanging up customers' coats, clearing up, washing cups and brushing the floor.



This is a corner shop. Jobs in a corner shop might include stacking shelves, dusting, and moving and opening boxes.



This is an office. Jobs in an office might include photocopying, typing, shredding paper and using the telephone.



This is a day care nursery. Jobs in a nursery might include making juice, playing with children, washing paint pots and helping children to put on their coats.
