| A2 Single Award Cash-in (6 unit award) | Candidates must complete AS units SHC1, SHC2 and SHC3 with mandatory A2 unit AHC3 plus two optional units from AHC1, AHC2, AHC4 or AHC5. |
| A2 Double Award Cash-in (12 unit award) | Candidates must complete six AS units, the mandatory A2 units AHC1, AHC2, AHC3, AHC4 and AHC5 plus one optional A2 unit AHC6 or AHC7. |

The Uniform Mark boundaries will not change for the lifetime of this specification. However, the Raw Mark boundaries will be set independently in each examination series.

If you are planning to use these Raw Mark boundaries to estimate future performance and grades, they must be used with caution, as they change each series.

Candidates who completed AS units in Summer 2022 will have been awarded an overall UMS total for AS based on their performance in all units, or the mandatory units only scaled out of the maximum UMS (whichever was the highest).

The AS UMS from Summer 2022 will be aggregated with A2 units' UMS in Summer 2023 to arrive at a final UMS and grade for the subject.

Candidates retaking their A Level from Summer 2022 are entitled to same assessment arrangements as offered in Summer 2022. Their final grade will be based on their performance at A2 only, and scaled out of the maximum UMS for the subject.

| Awarding A* A Level Single Award (6 units) | A* grade will be awarded to candidates who have met both of the following criteria: 1 gain an A grade overall at A level (480+ UMS out of 600 UMS); and 2 gain 90%, or more, of the maximum UMS on the combined totals of their A2 units (324+ UMS out of 360 UMS). |
| Awarding A*A* A Level Double Award (12 units) | An A*A* grade will be awarded to candidates who have met both of the following criteria: 1 gain an AA grade overall at Double Award A level (960+ UMS out of 1200 UMS); and 2 gain 90%, or more, of the max UMS on the combined totals of their six A2 units (648+ UMS out of 720 UMS). |
| Awarding A*A A Level Double Award (12 units) | An A*A grade will be awarded to candidates who have met both of the following criteria: 1 gain an AA grade overall at Double Award A level (960+ UMS out of 1200 UMS); and 2 gain 90%, or more, of the max UMS on their best three A2 units (including performance in a written paper). |
| The A* grade will be awarded for A level qualifications only. It will not be awarded at AS level or for individual units. | |
