

Remember that in 2022:

- Students could choose to omit a unit of assessment in most subjects, reducing the number of exams/assessments you had to sit.
- If you're completing a full A level qualification, **only A2 units count towards your overall A level grade**. AS grades awarded in 2021 do not contribute.
- If you completed all units, you'll receive the **uniform mark and grade** from your performance in either a) all units or b) the mandatory unit(s) only – whichever is higher.

A note on unit and qualification marks

If you notice that your **Final Uniform Marks** don't match the total of the **Uniform Marks** you achieved on your units, don't worry! It's because all students are graded out of the **same** uniform marks total in each qualification.

For example, if your best performance represents 70% of the uniform marks available in your completed unit(s), this will be converted to 70% of the maximum available for your overall qualification.

Mandatory unit only	Scores 65/80 uniform marks (81.3%)	Grade A	✔

Y beside Unit 1 indicates only this unit was used in grading
