

Students seeking an overall GCSE grade for the first time in Summer 2023 will receive a grade based on their achievement in all GCSE units/components.

For students who received a GCSE level grade in 2022, under the alternative arrangements, and have re-entered one or more units in 2023, the following applies:

- If you completed the mandatory GCSE unit(s) in 2022 and have re-entered the mandatory unit(s) in 2023, you will receive a GCSE grade based on your highest uniform mark in the mandatory unit(s).
- If you completed all GCSE units in 2022, or completed the mandatory unit(s) only in 2022 and have now chosen to complete the other unit(s), you will receive a GCSE level grade based on the uniform marks achieved in a) all GCSE units or b) mandatory GCSE unit(s) – whichever is higher.

The examples below are for GCSE Business Studies, where Units 2 and 3 were mandatory units in 2022.

Example 1 – Provisional Statement of Results

Note the student also entered Unit 2 (GBU2) in Summer 2022, scoring 79 uniform marks – this was not counted towards their final grade as shown below.

This student completed all units in 2022 and has re-sat Unit 2 in 2023. They have been graded on all units as this represents their best performance – shown below:

All units	99+82+42=223/300 uniform marks (74.3%)	Grade B	✓
Mandatory units only	82+42=124/180 uniform marks (68.9%)	Grade C*	✗

Y indicates these are the units that were used in grading.

Example 2 – Provisional Statement of Results

Note the student also entered Unit 1 (GBU1) in Summer 2022 scoring 76 uniform marks and re-entered this unit (GBU1) in Summer 2023 scoring 80 uniform marks. These were not counted towards their final grade as shown below.

This student has completed all units in 2022 and has re-sat units 1 and 2 in 2023. They have been graded on mandatory units 2 and 3 as this represents their best performance – shown below:

All units	$80+101+45=226/300$ uniform marks (75.3%)	Grade B	✘
Mandatory units only	$101+45=146/180$ uniform marks (81.1%)	Grade A	✔

Y indicates these are the units that were used in grading.
