### **BIIAB's response to the post-accreditation monitoring report September 2006**

Following the post accreditation monitoring report conducted by the Qualifications and Curriculum Authority (QCA) in September 2006, BIIAB are delighted with the positive outcome.

Within the report QCA identified one accreditation condition as follows:

BIIAB must ensure that principal examiners recognise that there may be times when decisions made by examiners can be changed and have a documented procedure that principal examiners can follow in order to make and record changes. (The statutory regulation of external qualifications in England, Wales and Northern Ireland 2004, paragraph 64)

This accreditation has now been met. A new procedure has been implemented outlining the process for principal examiners to make and record changes to candidate marks.

BIIAB found the observations made by QCA to be useful, as such they will be included as actions within BIIAB's continuous improvement programme.
